



## IN THE SPOTLIGHT: HALTON



The iFEED Program was launched in 2020 in the early phase of the COVID-19 pandemic to serve vulnerable communities through safe spaces where they could be supported confidentially and with dignity and respect.

We engage in year-round food rescue and redistribution activities that support students in need and their families in Halton Region largely through local schools in the Halton Catholic District School Board.

We also serve adults, children, and their families who currently receive specialized health and daily living support from community organizations.

A typical individual family bin could contain loaves of bread, savoury and sweet pastries, locally grown fruits and vegetables when they come into season, farm-fresh eggs, and other donated items as they become available.
